 - o Library Committee
 - Maggie noted via email that she'd like to work with government groups to populate library, concerned about Green New Deal letter from last month, but realizes it followed the procedures
 - From Maggie via email The library submission process has been simplified and multiple documents can be uploaded at one time. But we wonder how to get more companies, government agencies involved in uploading information. In putting together a powerpoint in the last few days on zero waste and the green new deal for my local solid waste advisory board I realized that some key EPA documents are not online anymore. This library project cannot be more important. I was disappointed earlier last month that this kind of key information about carbon inputs from production of goods and packaging contained in these missing documents (which at least I have in key pie charts) was NOT included in the NRC letter to Rep. Ocasio-Cortez. How fast this information is being lost altogether, even to those of us who should know it fluently.

From Leslie via email (Mute issues) - Everyone – Please recommend speakers for the following topics for the Resource Recycling conference

- a. **Plastics Pollution and Elimination** (or something to that effect, including Connect the Cap, Single-use, Waste
- b. Markets and Community Responses to National Sword
- c. Upstream Management of Resources to Minimize Wasting (Loop, Circular Economy, Reuse)
- d. Disaster Debris

The Conference Committee evaluated the proposal received to host the National Zero Waste Conference from the California Resource Recovery Association (CRRA) and the Northern CA Recycling Association (NCRA). That proposal was for the National Zero Waste Conference to be convened on 3/18-19, 2020, the day after the annual NCRA Recycling Update conference.

Dave Keeling raised concern about a conflict of dates for this proposal. The Carolina Recycling Association (CRA) conference for 2020 is scheduled for 3/16-19 in Raleigh, NC. NERC's conference this year was 3/20-21 (I don't know dates yet for their 2020 conference), and the KOR Kansas Recycling Conference was 3/19 in 2019.

In reviewing this issue and the CRRA/NCRA Proposal, the following 3 Options were identified: (see link for more details)

- 1. NRC proceed with CRRA/NCRA proposal
- 2. NRC proceed with CRRA, and explore alternate dates/locations.
- 3. NRC proceed to select another date and location
 It would be great for the Board to provide input on these 3 options by 4-12
 - Stephen Deposit legislation should be topic for conference
- Fundraising Committee (Gordon)
- o Policy Committee (McPoland/Bantillo/Dreckmann)
 - Framework for Advancing Container Recovery Draft Policy
 - Container Deposit Bill [Motion redacted]
 - Kerrin noted putting policy out front instead of collaboration on a continually evolving topic, don't want to be seen as promoting one method over the other instead of being a forum for thoughtful conversation
 - Amy Roth from ROC should we be looking for support for this from ROCs? Wants to identify what the role of the ROC is and how they can be involved in the process
 - Barb question about history, in favor of policy
 - Dave impressed with meetings of minds to develop policy, but agrees with Kerrin. Envisions a national town hall type of discussion first, either webinar or streaming, but to first get together a larger group of stakeholders. Is this the way, moving forward, to improve quality, etc. Feels it is too quick to approve the policy
 - *Barb happy to wait on voting*
 - Susie uneasy about beverage manufacturing companies position on this, does think we should move forward, maybe it is a matter of wordsmithing – change "preferred" to "vitally important" etc.
 - Wayne Coke reps at plastics conference noted they are formulating responses to container deposits
 - Bill mistake to make policy without follow through, need dialog
